Part-time Group Facilitator Position Available

The Neighborhood House believes that all people living with loss deserve a special place where they can connect with others, receive the support and help they need to heal, and discover their own strength and resilience. It is our mission to provide support groups to individuals and families struggling in the aftermath of loss so that they can grieve at their own pace. We aim to restore hope, and provide a community of kindness, respect and compassion.

We are looking to hire experienced part-time group facilitators for our Connections support group programs. The position provides direct services for a growing non-profit organization. The Neighborhood House delivers support group services for people living with traumatic loss due to suicide and drug overdose and provides programs focusing on suicide and substance abuse prevention. Our programs operate in 8-week sessions throughout the year in Sayville and Riverhead, NY.

The Group Facilitator will report to the organization's Program Coordinator.

Responsibilities include:

- Pre-planning and implementation of the support group program Connections, working collaboratively with Program Coordinator and co-Facilitators.
- Facilitate Connections program delivering our unique model of support which incorporates a variety of therapeutic approaches with the overall goal of building a sense of connectedness and community with others who are grieving.
- Ability to identify and assess changing needs throughout the group process and implement clinical intervention.
- Occasionally participate in the promotion of organization and participation in conferences, fundraisers and other local community events.

Education / Qualifications:

- Licensed NYS Mental Health Professional; LMSW, LCSW, LMHC, PhD, PsyD, et al.
- Experience with grief and traumatic loss preferred but not required.
- Experience with group facilitation.
- Excellent communication skills and ability to handle difficult situations professionally.
- Valid NYS Drivers License, with the ability to travel locally.
- Flexible schedule, with the ability to work evenings.
